- 1. The Armed Police Force, Nepal Welfare Service Center invites *electronic* bids from eligible bidders for the procurement of Recovery Truck under International Competitive Bidding Single Stage Two Envelope, for deployment of Armed Police Force Personnel in United Nations Peacekeeping Mission. *Procurement procedure is being done Under the special circumstances as specified in Public Procurement Act and Regulation.*
- 2. Under the Single Stage, Two Envelope Procedure, Bidders are required to submit simultaneously (i) the Technical Bid and the other (ii) the Price Bid, as per the provision of ITB 23 of the Bidding Document.

- 4. Bidder who chooses to submit their bid electronically may download the bidding documents for e-submission from PPMO's e-GP system www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp. Bidders, submitting their bid electronically, should deposit the cost of bidding document Fee NRs. 5,000/- in the following Rajaswa (revenue) account as specified below.

- Electronic bids must be submitted to the office of The Armed Police Force, Nepal Welfare Service Center, through PPMO's e-GP system <u>www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp</u> on or before *12:00* hrs on 13th Nov., 2022 Bids received after this deadline will be rejected.
- 6. The bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 13:00 hrs on 13th November, 2022 at the office of *The Armed Police Force, Nepal Welfare Service Center*. Bids must be valid for a period of 90 days from the date of bid opening and must be accompanied by a scanned copy of the bid security minimum USD 4,000.00 or NRS. 5,28,040/- or Equivalent to any convertible foreign currency in pdf format, which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid.
- 7. If the last date of purchasing and /or submission falls on a government holiday, then the next working day shall be considered as the last date. In such case the validity period of the bid and bid security shall remain the same as specified for the original last date of bid submission.
